
For residents in the area bounded by **Choriton Road and Stretford Road**



The 2025 adidas Manchester Marathon will see 36.000 participants take to the streets of Manchester & Trafford this April and will see an exciting change of a brand new finish line on Oxford Road.


For residents in the Hulme Park area

Please see the below EXIT route available out of the area which avoids the closed Chorlton Road and Stretford Road. This will be via Reilly Street, onto Leaf Street, onto a barriered off lane of Stretford Road, from which you will need to turn left to get onto Princess Road.



For residents within the estate near Greenhays Lane

Please see the below route which can be used in both directions using Greenhays Lane and Princess Road. These roads are open throughout the day



For residents in the area north of Denmark Road and bounded by Lloyd St North and Oxford Road

You will be able to leave the area heading west on Denmark Rd towards Princess Rd on the event closed roads during the following times: from when they close at 4am until 10.15am, and then again from 5.50pm until 7pm. At 7pm Denmark Rd and the section of Oxford Rd south of Denmark Rd re-open. Oxford Rd north of Denmark Rd will remain closed until 11.59pm.
